



V-LUMIX Glow in the dark tape offers many options to fulfil the requirements of different application purposes and budgets. So, it's very important to have a general picture of the product numbers of V-LUMIX glow in the dark tape.

Here, we are going to introduce our product numbers and help you to read as much information as possible from our product numbers.

### **1. Our product numbers consist of three parts and connected by en dash"-"**

#### **2. The First Part: Letters+Numbers+Letters**

- a. ending with "T": PET material film
- b. ending with "P": PVC material film
- c. ending with "NS": Anti-slip film

#### **3. The Second Part: Numbers**

- a. The number here indicates the luminance after 10min and 60min respectively from the activation ceased when measured per DIN 67510 Part 1.
- b. When it's a three-digit number, the first two digits is for 10min and the last digit is for 60min
- c. When it's a five-digit number, the first three digits is for 10min and the last two digits is for 60min

**Important Note:** When the number is greater than 10010, it means that this quality is complied with NYC RS6-1 and RS6-1A.

#### **3. The Third Part: Letters**

Some of our product numbers end with two or three letters, which standard for the glowing color most of the time, or show the appearance color in some cases. e.g.

- FLY: Fluorescent yellow
- BL: Blue
- GR: Green
- ...

#### **4. For Example: PL9T-355-RD**

This product number tells that this item is PET material film, 35mcd/m<sup>2</sup> after 10min, 5mcd/m<sup>2</sup> after 60min, and glowing color is red.
